#### **Social Services**

- We have 3 guests who are homeless using our storage pods for their belongings currently. We have created an agreement form and will review each person's usage every 3 months.
- We are providing guests with laundry gift cards and detergent strips as requested. Cards must be returned to be replenished.
- We are providing 2 guests who are homeless with membership to local gyms so they can access hot showers and shelter from inclement weather.

### **Meals Operations**

• On October 24th, we will be offering our guests the opportunity to bring their packaged meal inside to eat. This is an interim step before we return to full inside dining as we used to do.
